



## **COVID 19 Preventative Measures for the Teams, Media and Service Providers attending the FIS World Cup Speed Skiing “Chocken” Idre & FIS Speed Skiing March 11th-13th 2021.**

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic has affected every aspect of life for both business and individuals worldwide. The Swedish Ski Federation, FIS, Idre Fjäll and LOC are happy that this year welcome you all back to the FIS World Cup & FIS Speed Skiing.

The **FIS World Cup Speed “Chocken” Idre & FIS Speed Skiing 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2021** will take place with enhanced safety measures. Based on the current directive by the Swedish Ministry for Health and exceeding measures by Idre Fjäll as well as by FIS, we herewith send this measure catalogue to you all. By accepting the order and by registering to the event, every individual accepts the content of this measure catalogue entirely.

### **General information:**

Red zone incl: Athletes, registered team members, LOC, internal media crew, the Jury and race committee.

Blue zone incl: External media and other accredited persons.

**To follow the FIS prevention guidelines the LOC together with the local healthcare have decided that everyone in the red zone need to have a negative PCR test upon arrival or proof of antibodies inside 60 days from first competition day.**

The PCR test should be inside 72 hours of your arrival to Idre Fjäll. Send the test certificate or document regarding antibodies to the LOC([jan.magnusson@valmet.com](mailto:jan.magnusson@valmet.com)).

People in the red zone need also to fill in the FIS health questionnaire and send it to LOC([jan.magnusson@valmet.com](mailto:jan.magnusson@valmet.com)).

### **Basics**

- Individual Responsibility
- Hygiene measure (frequent handwashing, frequent disinfection)
- Minimum distance of 1,5 meter everywhere

Mouth- nose protection

- In Sweden there is no law or recommendation to wear mouth – nose protection – but of course individuals are free to wear their mouth – nose protection!



- All the staff that are close to the teams will be wearing mouth-nose protection
- **We also will follow the FIS guidelines which means that all the Teams and service providers will have to wear mouth-nose protection in the competition area (red zone). All staff/volunteers inside the competition area will also wear mouth nose protection.**

### **Journey to Idre Fjäll**

- Do not travel to the venue with symptoms of COVID-19
- If people close to you have been affected with COVID-19, please contact your superior and refrain from travelling to the event.
- Avoid stops when travelling to the venue
- Avoid contact with other people – especially team members.

The LOC advise everyone who's flying to use **Stockholm airport, Arlanda**. Idre Fjäll or LOC are not able to do any PCR test for travel certificate. Info regarding travel certificates(covid 19):

### **Event Venue**

- Keep minimum distance!
- Stay only in the allocated and marked zones (Red or Blue zone).
- For service providers and media: Please avoid direct contact to sports teams and wear mouth-nose protection. As well as avoid contact with other staff members and members of the press.
- When riding in the chair lift all persons must be of the same team or same working group.
- No Spectators inside the event venue (red and blue zone).

### **Accommodation**

- No check-in at the Idre Fjäll reception, pick up your envelope at the check-in box, see attached map.
- Breakfast and dinner:  
In the restaurant you will be seated at a table where you will be served – no buffet area.  
Note: no lunch will be served at the race arena.
- Due to regulations from the Swedish government no more than 4 people are allowed at the same table.



- Due to regulations from the Swedish government the restaurant is not allowed to be open no longer than 20:00 (you must leave before 20:30).

### **COVID – 19 communication**

- In case of symptoms inform the LOC as well as your supervisor immediately.
- LOC will activate COVID- 19 chain of measures.
- In case of symptoms, stay in your accommodation.  
If some one tested positive all in the same household will be isolated and due to Swedish regulations the others member of that household will not be able to compete even if they are negative – all in the household will be isolated and put in quarantine.  
The Swedish regulations are that you need to be in quarantine seven days, and two of those days without symptoms.
- All communication concerning COVID-19 must be discussed and agreed with FIS and the LOC.
- LOC does not represent additional cost associated with quarantine.

### **To minimize the risk of infection the LOC recommends**

- Small groups
- Limit contact to other persons
- Avoid contact with tourists/fans
- Spend your free time only with members of your team/group.

### **Additional measures:**

- There will be no additional programme or audience in the finish area except the prize ceremony.
